Location: Paoli Memorial Grounds, Monument Avenue, Malvern PA.

5K Race: 9:00 am start. The 5K course is a challenging, all-terrain, **Cross Country** inspired race that is run through wooded trails and grassy areas on and around the Paoli Memorial Grounds.

Prizes: Top male and female, Top Military Personnel and Veteran, 12 and under, 13-15, 16-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70 and over.

Kids Fun Run: 8:45 am start. Kids 12 and under are invited to participate in the kids fun run. The race will take place on the grass area at the Paoli Memorial Grounds.
